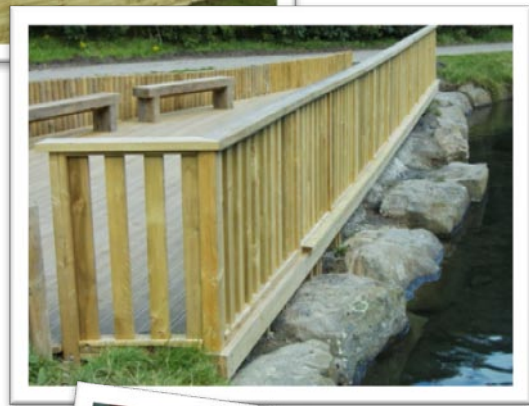


Case study: Accessibility
